 - Turn left onto Rue Royale.
4. **Laurent Gerbaud** (Rue Ravenstein 2D, 1000 Brussels)
 - Head south on Rue Royale towards Rue de la Montagne.
 - Turn right onto Rue de la Montagne.
 - Continue onto Rue de l'Ecuyer.
 - Turn left onto Rue de la Madeleine.
 - Continue onto Rue de la Régence.
 - Turn right onto Rue Ravenstein.
5. **Wittamer** (Place du Grand Sablon 6-12, 1000 Brussels)
 - Head south on Rue Ravenstein towards Rue de la Régence.
 - Turn left onto Rue de la Régence.
 - Continue straight to stay on Rue de la Régence.
 - Turn left onto Place du Grand Sablon.
